North Shore Railroad Company Receives ImPAct Award from Governor Corbett

Hershey-On Friday, Governor Tom Corbett recognized 50 Pennsylvania businesses and entrepreneurs with the 2014 Governor's ImPAct Awards.

The awards, designed by Governor Corbett, the Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development (DCED), and Team PA Foundation, are given to companies for creating jobs, developing ideas, reaching new markets and making positive contributions in local communities.

North Shore Railroad, nominated by Northumberland County Planning Director Pat Mack, was proud to be the recipient of the Small Business Impact Award for the Central Pennsylvania Region. This award recognized North Shore Railroad's 30 year history of being a small family owned and operated company that grew its business from 15 people handling 1,200 carloads to 98 people handling more than 30,000 carloads per year. Also considered was the fact that in its 30 year history, North Shore Railroad has never laid off or furloughed any employee and, in the last year, has contributed more than \$7 million to the local economy.
